Patients Need Help!



- No coordinated data system to help patients understand and manage information
- Patients often have a fairly small timeframe to make important healthcare decisions
- Patients and caregivers often receive limited clinical trials and disease information & guidance



Pathology Data, Data, Data: Barriers or Building Blocks??

- Data Technical jargon: Confusing to patients?
- Report data clinical implications? Clarity or not?
- Tissue sequencing data: Mutational Burden



- Patient access to data before clinician:
- Patient understanding of data: Room to improve?
- Expectations of data are all over the place!!
- How can data translate into better patient care?

Consequences of Poor Quality- \$

- Erodes public confidence
- Wastes time & money
- Impedes clinical benefit
- Takes another 100+++ Years


